WHAT IS A CONFINED SPACE?

The term ‘confined space’ is any work area where there is a possibility of an atmosphere which has

- deficiency or excess of oxygen,
- flammable or explosive atmospheres,
- harmful gas, fume or vapour,
- free flowing solids or an increasing level of liquid
- excessively high temperature.

This includes such places as open-topped tanks, chemical reactors, unventilated rooms, ovens or furnaces, slurry tanks, grain and flour silos, water wells and underground sewerage or water pipeline.

Greenday operators are trained and properly equipped to work in confined spaces to the highest safety standards. The operator entering a chamber is attached to a winch and carries a gas detector and Breathing Apparatus (BA) equipment. The gas detector monitors atmospheric changes so that he can be winched to safety if necessary.

For larger chambers we use a constant air feed to our operators which allows them sufficient time to carry out larger tasks safely.
